Environmental cleaning and disinfection in quarantine area

As coronaviruses may have the potential for widespread contamination of patient rooms or environments, effective cleaning and decontamination is vital.

Daily cleaning:

- Cleaning and decontamination should only be performed by trained staff with the use of the appropriate PPE: surgical mask- gloves-gown- eye protection(if splash only).
- Cleaning and disinfection of the clinic is done three times daily and on need.
- Cleaning and disinfection of the quarantine people rooms is done according to quarantine rules to minimize exposure.
- Cleaning of the lobby and corridors is done daily and on need.
- There should be more frequent cleaning of commonly used hand-touched surfaces or lobby areas (at least twice per day).
- for non-porous surfaces like floors and other surfaces perform 2-step cleaning and disinfection:
 - Clean with neutral detergent.
 - Then disinfect with a chlorine-based disinfectant in the form of a solution at a strength of 1,000 ppm available chlorine.

Terminal cleaning:

- Empty the rooms for 1 hour (24 hours if time permits)
- Start cleaning for 1-2 days twice a day.
- Cleaning of non-porous surfaces as above.
- For soft porous surfaces such as carpted floor, rug, drapes and curtain, perform routine cleaning to remove visible contamination.
- The air ventilation system does not require cleaning or disinfection.
- After cleaning, the place is ready to accept new guest.
